

RESOLUTION NO. R25-65

A RESOLUTION BY THE TROTWOOD CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF AN APPLICATION FOR FEDERAL FUNDING FROM THE INFRASTRUCTURE INVESTMENT AND JOBS ACT THROUGH THE SURFACE TRANSPORTATION PROGRAM BY THE MIAMI VALLEY REGIONAL PLANNING COMMISSION.

WHEREAS, the Miami Valley Regional Planning Commission (“MVRPC”) has solicited local government entities to submit new transportation projects for funding consideration in the Surface Transportation Program (“STP”); and

WHEREAS, the City of Trotwood has committed to a timely project development schedule; and

WHEREAS, the City of Trotwood will commit the necessary resources to support the estimated local cost portion of this project, and the project will be submitted to MVRPC:

1. Turner Road (Salem Avenue to Wolf Road) Resurfacing – Estimated Local Share of \$310,508.10 to include a 21% match of resurfacing costs, preliminary engineering, 10% contingency, and preliminary concrete work to replace existing walks and curb ramps; and

WHEREAS, The City of Trotwood requests Exemption 4 for this project, as the project consists of maintenance, repair or resurfacing of an existing cross-section only.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROTWOOD, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION I:

This Resolution shall serve to authorize the transmittal and submittal of an application for the following transportation project to MVRPC for funding consideration through the STP:

1. Turner Road (Salem Avenue to Wolf Road) Resurfacing – Estimated Local Share of \$310,508.10 to include a 21% match of resurfacing costs, preliminary engineering, 10% contingency, and preliminary concrete work to replace existing walks and curb ramps.

SECTION II:

The City Manager is hereby authorized to sign on behalf of the City the application for funds as referred to in Section I of this Resolution.

SECTION III:

The City Manager is hereby directed and authorized to take or cause to be taken all other action necessary and proper to secure the funding sought by the application referred to herein, and provide any additional information sought by reviewing agencies during the time the application is under review. The City Manager is further directed and authorized to cause compliance with all reporting requirements required by the MVRPC as required as part of the funding process.

SECTION IV:

Upon application approval, the City hereby states its commitment to the local contribution for the project as identified in these applications, including local contribution of costs exceeding the current estimates or subsequent revised estimates as accepted by the MVRPC.

SECTION V:

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were done in an open meeting of this Council, and that any and all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including, but not limited to Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION VI:

This Resolution shall take effect and be in full force from and after the date of its passage.
